Who is this course for?

This course is for individuals looking to develop their coaching skills for career progression or new opportunities. It is suitable for professionals across all sectors, including private, public, and third-sector organisations. Potential roles include:

- Professional Coach
- Leadership Coach
- Internal Coach
- Team Coach

What qualification will you gain?

Participants on this programme will gain a Level 5 Diploma in Coaching and professional recognition at Practitioner level from the European Mentoring and Coaching Council (EMCC).

What will you study?

This programme provides progression for individuals looking to further develop their expertise and careers in coaching. It equips participants with an in-depth understanding of coaching principles and advanced techniques. All participants will study the knowledge, skills, and behaviours required for a professional coaching role, in addition to developing core coaching competencies. Participants will participate in active coaching practice with a range of participants from different sectors.

Examples of module content

- Planning and facilitating effective coaching sessions
- Applying various coaching models, tools, and questioning techniques
- Upholding ethical standards and understanding relevant legislation
- Strategic planning and implementation of organisational coaching programmes
- Engaging in continuous personal development and supervision

Teaching, learning and assessment

This is a 14-month qualification followed by an assessment period. Teaching includes face-to-face conference days, remote tutorials and supervision, asynchronous study and formative and summative tasks. Participants must demonstrate a minimum number of coaching hours with a range of clients, and maintain a portfolio of work product evidence. Participants will learn from experts in the field, and have the opportunity to observe and practice coaching in action. Participants will be supported in their studies and practice by a professional tutor, and a team of programme tutors and expert facilitators. There are no written exams.

Assessment

Assessment for this programme is a combination of coursework, practice and a professional portfolio of evidence. At the end of the qualification, participants will also be assessed for professional recognition by EMCC, at Practitioner level.

English and maths requirements

Applicants should hold a minimum of level 2 in English and maths, or equivalent. Applicants without level 2 English or maths will have the opportunity to gain these qualifications at no cost while undertaking the programme. Reasonable requests for exemption will be considered.

Entry requirements

There are no formal entry requirements, however applicants must demonstrate the following eligibility requirements:

- Minimum age 19
- Be employed full or part-time in a relevant job role
- Completion of an entry assessment to demonstrate early coaching competencies
- A participant may be ineligible if they hold a higher level qualification in the same area of study. LETTA can advise candidates as to eligibility.

Outcomes

After successfully completing all assessment activities, participants will gain:

- Diploma in Coaching (Level 5 with 37 credits)
- Professional recognition at Practitioner level

Funding

This qualification is self-funded. Fees can be paid upfront or in installments.
